Re: By-Laws changes

Presented in accordance with Article 23, Sections 1 and 2, and to enable membership voting, the following By-Law amendments are proposed.

In Article, 13, Section 5, delete the following:

“In order to be eligible to vote in the election at the final General Meeting of the year, a member must have satisfactory attendance at General Meetings, as stated in Article 14, Section 4.”

In Article, 14, Section 4, delete the following:

“...they do lose their right to vote in the annual elections and...”

so that the last sentence shall read:

“Members in Good Standing who do not fulfill their meeting requirements (i.e., attending three of four scheduled general meetings) do not lose their membership but they cannot run for any office or for a board seat in that calendar year.”
