Revise Article 12, Section 10

Alternate #1

Section 10 - Applicants Assessments**

All applicants shall be assessed a Three Dollar (\$3.00) applicant assessment fee for each softball and/or baseball game he/she umpires and which is assigned by and umpired for this Association. Junior Officials working per Article 15, Section 12, shall also be assessed this fee. This applicant assessment fee shall be terminated for the remainder of the current year after an applicant has umpired sixty (60) "work units" during the current year, as defined in Article 13, Section 5.

Alternate #2

Section 10 - Applicants Assessments**

All applicants shall be assessed an applicant assessment fee which shall be One Dollar and Fifty Cents (\$1.50) for each softball game and/or Three Dollars (\$3.00) for each baseball game he/she umpires and which is assigned by and umpired for this Association. Junior Officials working per Article 15, Section 12, shall also be assessed this fee. This applicant assessment fee shall be terminated for the remainder of the current year after an applicant has umpired sixty (60) "work units" during the current year, as defined in Article 13, Section 5.

Add to Article 20, Section 6 - New

Section 6 - NCUA Code of Ethics**

Add following Article VI as follows:

Article VII

State CIF Compliance

As part of his/her registration for the current year, as stated in Article 12, Section 13, each umpire shall certify his/her compliance with CIF Code of Conduct requirements by subscribing to/signing the current year's CIF document "CIF-Pursuing Victory With Honor- (Suggested) Code of Conduct for Officials" or any equivalent document authorized by CIF. The applicable CIF Code of Conduct document will be provided to the umpire by the Association. If the umpire fails to subscribe to said CIF document, the assignments of the umpire to any scholastic baseball and/or softball games may be limited and/or withdrawn by the responsible Assigning Secretary, at his/her discretion, until the umpire is in compliance. The umpire will be in compliance when the umpire has read the CIF document and has notified the responsible Assigning Secretary, either verbally or in writing, of his/her acknowledgement of its provisions.

Add to Article 12, Section 13.

Section 13 - Umpire Registration and Late Registration Fee**

Umpire registration for the current year shall include payment of ASA Fees (softball umpires only - see Section 6 of this Article), Liability Insurance (all umpires - see Section 8 of this Article), and State CIF Code of Conduct compliance (see Article 20, Section 6, Article VII). These payments ... rest is the same
