Negotiation of Game Fees

Game fees are to be only negotiated by the NCUA Vice President of their respective sport. Umpires are NOT to negotiate their own fees when their game/s is longer in time limit or more innings than what they were assigned for. They are to notify their respective NCUA Assignor to handle the matter.

Change of Fields

When you arrive at the ballpark, and the coach had to make a necessary field change due to unforeseen circumstances, i.e., field unplayable, etc., you must first notify your assignor of the field change. This is required because of insurance repercussions.

Written Opinions

Any umpire may voice their own opinion whether written or verbal. These opinions would solely be one's own personal opinions; not NCUA's. Do not include NCUA in these opinions as you are NOT representing NCUA when writing/presenting such opinions. In order to do so, you must first obtain authority from the NCUA Executive Board.
