### 2011 BASEBALL UNIFORM POLICY

#### SHIRTS

Navy Blue collared. NCUA Patch provided by the association shall be attached to the shirt on the left pocket. Numbers is provided by umpire and shall be attached to the right sleeve red with white borders. Shirts may be long or short sleeve. Honig's are preferred.

Catalog # HMSLX, HMLLX, HMSWN.

#### UNDERSHIRTS

Undershirts shall be Navy blue to match the collared shirt. They may be long sleeved or thermal such as Honig's Warm Skin HF67, or other such items such as Under Armor

#### PANTS

Umpires should have a pair of pants for each position – Plate and Bases. The pants shall be charcoal grey. Pants from Honig's- Plate Pants – B21AP, Base Pants – B22AP or equal.

#### BALL BAGS & BELT

Umpires should have two Grey or Navy blue ball bags and one black belt.

#### SOCKS AND SHOES

Umpires should have black socks as well as one pair of base shoes and one pair of plate shoes (shined and cleaned).

#### JACKETS

If purchased new shall be Honig's #K17 Navy blue or Honig's BS3 Honig's plate coat in Navy blue. NCUA Patch provided by the association shall be attached to the jacket on the left breast. Numbers is provided by umpire and shall be attached to the right sleeve red with white borders

## **HATS**

Umpires should have two NCUA hats: one long-billed hat for working the bases and one short-billed hat for working the plate. If plate umpire is using a baseball approved hockey mask/helmet, no hat is required.

## **OTHER NECESSARY UMPIRE ACCESSORIES**

Indicators, plate brushes, writing increments & paper shall be supplied by each umpire. Plate gear, such as shin guards, chest protector, and face mask shall be at the discretion of the individual umpire and conform to the minimum standard of baseball umpiring for High School. Use of equipment not specifically designed for the umpiring of baseball is not to be used.

**Starting in 2011 the NCUA Baseball Vice President or his assigned designee shall inspect all NCUA baseball umpires' uniform and equipment prior to the start of the season. This year's inspection will be either January 19<sup>th</sup>, or January 20<sup>th</sup>. Every umpire must comply or they will be placed on Low Priority until corrected.**

**NCUA has contacted Honig's and they will be available the following week for immediate equipment purchases.**
